

ABOUT PROGRESSIVE TENNIS ...

Progressive Tennis is an international trend in junior development. Fully endorsed by Tennis Canada, the system used 'scaled-down' versions of courts, balls, racquets, and competition formats that are appropriate for Under 8 and U10 players.

The scaled equipment allows for easier play and successful tactics and techniques. Scaling equipment and competition is a standard development practice in many other sports.

In Europe, the system is used by the majority of the top tennis nations. For example, Roger Federer is the main spokesman for the system in Switzerland. Many of the current top European professionals got their start with Progressive Tennis.

The International Tennis Federation (ITF) is fully endorsing Progressive Tennis as part of their world-wide "Play & Stay" tennis initiative. (See: www.tennisplayandstay.com)

U10 = 3/4 Court Tennis



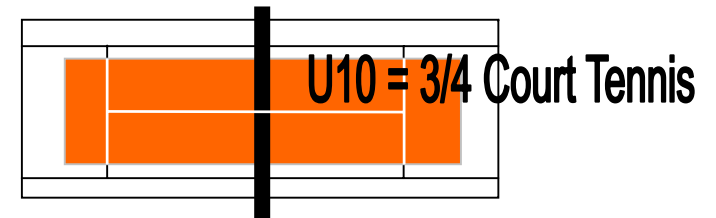
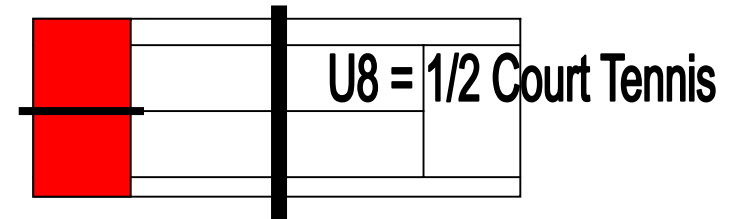

U8 1/2 Court Division:
(must be under 8 as of January 1, 2007)

U10 3/4 Court division:
(must be under 10 as of January 1, 2007)

NOTE: Boys and Girls will compete in the same events.

- **Entries close Tuesday, December 11th @ 6:00pm or when draw is full.**

Draw:

- The draw will be available on Thursday, December 13th @ 6pm. Players are expected to check their own draw times. **Phone (604) 913-4529 for times.**

Scheduling:

- Players must be available to play at all scheduled times. Players more than 15 minutes late may be defaulted.
- Play will be during a 3-4 hour block on Saturday and another 3-4 hour block on Sunday. Times may be adjusted according to number of entries.

Format:

- The format is a Round Robin where players are placed in 'pools' of 3-6 competitors. Depending on their performance in the Saturday Round Robin, players will be re-grouped for the Sunday Round Robin.

Play:

- **1/2 Court Matches:** Will be timed play (20 minutes per match). Games will be first player to reach 11 points with players serving 2 points at a time.
- **3/4 Court Matches:** Will be timed play (25-30 minutes per round depending on draw size). Scoring will be best out of 3 short sets (first to 4 games, standard tie-breaker at 4-4). If the sets are tied 1-1, a standard tie-breaker will be used as the 3rd set (The tie-breaker will count as the third set). Games will be no-ad scoring (at 40-40, next point wins)
