Open division draws will be done Wednesday, April 23 at 5:00pm at the hotel.

All other draws will be available April 17, 2008 at 12 noon on www.usta.com.
Play begins April 24 at 8:00am for all divisions except junior divisions.
Players must check in at tournament desk at least 30 minutes before scheduled match time.
All Quad players must be verified by the ITF.
