Registration:



Entry fees may be paid by online registration or mailed with cheque enclosed. Players may enter two events.



No refunds will be issued once the draw has been made.



All BC residents must hold a valid Tennis BC membership or pay the \$36.00 fee at the time of submitting the entry. This fee will include Membership for 2008.



All entries are subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee.

Play:



Matches will be the best of three tie-break sets. Third set match tiebreak may be played in lieu of a third set at referees discretion.



Alternate formats may be used for consolation matches.



Players should be dressed and ready to play 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match time. Players more than 15 minutes late when their match is called may be defaulted. Lateness, up to 15 minutes, will be penalized by loss of toss and 1, 2 or 3 games.



7 minutes is the maximum time allowed for warm-up.



Proper tennis attire and non-marking shoes are required.



The Tennis Canada Code of Conduct will be enforced by the Tournament Referee or other Officials.

Scheduling:



Players should be prepared to play from 2:00 pm.



Scheduling consideration will be given to players from out of town.
