	participate in the appropriate NJOS tournament and qualify for the qualifying spot
	at the Canadian Championship (exceptions will be studied by the coaches

DRAW SIZES	Stanley Park Open: limited to 64. There will be 8 spots in the main draw allocated
	for qualifiers for each U12 Boys and Girls if entries are oversubscribed.
	In the case of U12 entries are oversubscribed, 56 direct entry and 8 qualifiers will be
	accepted.

SEEDING	Seeding for all events will be based on the latest National Bank Rankings as of the
	Tuesday before the draw date.
QUALIFICATION	Each NJOS event will award one spot in the U12 and U14 age categories, both for

FISCHER JUNIOR	These will be determined as follows:
NATIONALS	The champion of each National Junior Open Series event automatically
	receives a spot in that age division.

OFFICIALS	2. If the champion is ineligible (i.e. has already qualified for a spot through the Provincial Qualifying Process, foreign player) then the spot will go to the next eligible player up to and including the 4 th place finisher. For example, if the champion is ineligible then the finalist receives the spot. If the finalist is ineligible, then the spot goes to the 3 rd place finisher followed by the 4 th place finisher if required. Provincial Referees, Roving and Chair umpires will be at each tournament. The draw
OFFICIALS	will be conducted by the Tournament Referee.
ACCOMMODATION	Tournament hotels, when available, will be indicated in the <i>Registration & Information</i> links above. Players may reserve their own rooms directly with these hotels.
PRACTICE COURTS	The amount and timing of practice courts available at each tournament will vary. Please contact the individual tournaments for information.
