- Familiarity/Experience with Red/Orange/Green U10 development
- Ability to deliver fun and active sessions for Instructional Clinics & Drill sessions & run Leagues.
- A professional, 'customer service' attitude
- A 'professional development' attitude with the commitment to invest time and money to improve coaching and client experience skills
- Ability to give private lessons
- Strong, friendly, interpersonal skills with the ability to relate to, and adapt, their communication to a broad range of ages (6-90yrs)
- Ability to work on a team as well as take and implement feedback from supervisory staff
- Ability to be responsible when unsupervised and take care of all off-court details regarding lessons (answering calls, meeting clients, booking lessons, following-up, etc.)

Certification/experience:

- Current TPA 'Active' status for Tennis Canada Club Professional 1 or above.
- Minimum 4 years coaching experience with a range of ages and levels.
