For Doubles, the average WTN of the team (average of two players' WTN) should be used to determine the appropriate NTRP level they should register in.

For Mixed Doubles, the WTN guidelines will follow Women Singles Guidelines.

## How to opt in:

If you have results in the system but are unable to view your WTN on your tournaments profile page, it is likely because you opted in to not sharing your match results data with the ITF back in 2020. In order to check this please:

- 1. Visit the tournaments site and log in
- 2. After you have logged in, click on your name on the top-right and select "Account Settings" from the drop-down menu
- 3. Scroll down to the "Consent" section
- 4. If you would like to show your WTN in your profile, make sure it says "Yes."
